Get started:

Log on to TheTalentEDProject.org

- 1. Register as a *College Access Professional*.** Search for your school or organization. If it's not listed, register as a new organization.
- 2. Activate your account.** You will receive an email invitation from support@thetalentedproject.org.
- 3. Gain full access to the site.** Once you set your password, you will be asked to complete a brief Knowledge Assessment.
- 4. Complete your profile.** Add information enabling you to be searched by colleges and make connections.
- 5. Engage your students.** Invite your students and help them set up their profiles and storyboards in order to be introduced to college recruiters.*

**Students must be either lower-income or first-generation college-goers and have a GPA of 2.7 (B-/C+) or higher.*
